



Creation Of Conditions For Inclusive Tourism In Uzbekistan

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Abstract: The article is devoted to the problems and prospects for the development of inclusive tourism in Uzbekistan. The significance of inclusive tourism as a tool for social integration and economic growth is considered. An analysis was conducted of the current state of the country's tourism infrastructure, focusing on the barriers faced by people with disabilities. International experience in creating an accessible environment in the tourism industry, which can be adapted to the conditions of Uzbekistan, has been described. The article proposes measures to modernize the infrastructure, introduce specialized services, increase the awareness of industry workers and use digital technologies. The author concludes that a comprehensive approach and state support are important for creating conditions that correspond to the principles of inclusion, which will allow Uzbekistan to improve the quality of tourism services and enhance its competitiveness on the international stage.

СОЗДАНИЕ УСЛОВИЙ ДЛЯ ИНКЛЮЗИВНОГО ТУРИЗМА В УЗБЕКИСТАНЕ

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Аннотация: Статья посвящена проблемам и перспективам развития инклюзивного туризма в Узбекистане. Рассматривается значение инклюзивного туризма как инструмента социальной интеграции и экономического роста. Проведен анализ текущего состояния туристической инфраструктуры страны с акцентом на барьеры, с которыми сталкиваются люди с ограниченными возможностями здоровья (ОВЗ). Описан



международный опыт создания доступной среды в туристической отрасли, который может быть адаптирован к условиям Узбекистана. В статье предложены меры по модернизации инфраструктуры, внедрению специализированных услуг, повышению осведомленности работников индустрии и использованию цифровых технологий. Автор делает вывод о важности комплексного подхода и государственной поддержки для создания условий, соответствующих принципам инклюзии, что позволит Узбекистану улучшить качество туристических услуг и повысить свою конкурентоспособность на международной арене.

Annotatsiya: Maqola O'zbekistonda inklyuziv turizmni rivojlantirish muammolari va istiqbollarga bag'ishlangan. Inklyuziv turizmning ijtimoiy integratsiya va iqtisodiy o'sish vositasi sifatidagi ahamiyati ko'rib chiqilgan. Mamlakat turizm infratuzilmasining hozirgi holati tahlil qilinib, nogironligi bo'lgan shaxslar duch keladigan to'siqlarga e'tibor qaratildi. O'zbekiston sharoitiga moslashtirilishi mumkin bo'lgan turizm sohasida qulay muhit yaratish bo'yicha xalqaro tajriba bayon etilgan. Maqolada infratuzilmani modernizatsiya qilish, ixtisoslashtirilgan xizmatlarni joriy etish, soha xodimlarining xabardorligini oshirish va raqamli texnologiyalardan foydalanish bo'yicha chora-tadbirlar taklif etilgan. Muallif inklyuzivlik tamoyillariga mos shart-sharoitlarni yaratish uchun kompleks yondashuv va davlat tomonidan qo'llab-quvvatlash muhimligi haqida xulosaga keladi, bu esa O'zbekistonga turizm xizmatlari sifatini yaxshilash va xalqaro maydonda raqobatbardoshligini oshirish imkonini beradi.

Introduction

In the context of globalization and the development of the tourism industry, inclusive tourism is becoming one of the key areas, providing equal opportunities for travel and recreation for all categories of the population, including people with disabilities. Uzbekistan, possessing a rich historical and cultural heritage, unique architecture, and hospitable traditions, has significant potential for attracting tourists from all over the world. However, to create conditions that correspond to the principles of inclusive tourism, it is necessary to develop infrastructure, adapt tourist facilities, and raise public awareness.

The purpose of this article is to analyze the current situation in the field of inclusive tourism in Uzbekistan, identify the main problems and propose ways to solve them. Main part

1. The concept and significance of inclusive tourism

2. Tourism in Uzbekistan

Uzbekistan attracts tourists thanks to the monuments of the Great Silk Road, its national cuisine and cultural traditions. Samarkand, Bukhara and Khiva, which are included in the UNESCO World Heritage List, are visited by thousands of tourists every year. However, to ensure accessibility of these facilities for people with disabilities, infrastructure needs to be modernized.

To date, the following problems can be identified:



1. Insufficient infrastructure accessibility.

Many historical monuments have complex architectural features (stairs, narrow passages), which makes it difficult for people with disabilities to visit them.

- Lack of adapted hotels, restaurants and vehicles.

2. Lack of specialized services.

o Lack of guides who can work with tourists with OVS.

o Limited access to informational materials, such as Braille maps or guidebooks.

3. Lack of awareness.

o Tourist companies and operators do not always take into account the needs of people with disabilities when developing routes.

o Lack of training for tourism personnel on inclusion issues.

3. International experience in developing inclusive tourism

A study of the experience of other countries shows that creating conditions for inclusive tourism is possible with a comprehensive approach. For example:

- Spain has successfully implemented adaptation programs for tourist facilities, including wheelchair accessible beaches, audio guides and guidebooks for visually impaired people.

- Italy adapted historical monuments such as the Colosseum, equipping them with ramps and elevators.

- Japan has developed a national "Barrier-free society" strategy that includes accessible transportation, information technology, and personnel training.

These examples can serve as a guide for implementing similar measures in Uzbekistan.

4. Ways to create conditions for inclusive tourism in Uzbekistan

To develop inclusive tourism in Uzbekistan, it is necessary to implement the following measures:

1. Infrastructure modernization.

Equipping historical monuments with ramps, elevators and handrails.

Adaptation of hotels, restaurants and public spaces for people with disabilities.

2. Development of specialized services.

Training guides to work with people with disabilities.

Creation of Brail-language audio-guides, guidebooks and multimedia information materials.

3. Increasing awareness.

Conducting training seminars for tourism industry workers.



Implementation of information campaigns aimed at popularizing inclusive tourism.

4. Using digital technologies.

- o Development of mobile applications with navigation and sign language translation functions.

Creation of online platforms with information about accessible routes and facilities.

5. State support and legal regulation.

- o Adoption of state programs aimed at developing inclusive tourism.

- o Introduction of tax benefits for organizations adapting their infrastructure and services.

One of the key areas of development of inclusive tourism in Uzbekistan is the modernization of tourism infrastructure, including historical monuments, hotels, restaurants and transport. Most of the country's architectural objects, such as the Registan in Samarkand or the Kalyan minaret in Bukhara, were built centuries ago, so their adaptation requires a special approach that takes into account the preservation of their cultural and historical value. For example, installing removable ramps or using virtual tours can make these objects accessible to people with disabilities without compromising their architectural integrity. Similarly, the creation of accessible public transport, including low-floor buses and adapted stations, will allow all categories of tourists to travel more widely, contributing to the development of domestic and international tourism.

It is impossible to develop inclusive tourism without raising the level of awareness and professional training of tourism industry workers. Guides, hotel administrators, and other industry professionals must be able to communicate with people with disabilities and understand their needs. This includes training in working with different categories of tourists: for example, using sign language to communicate with people with hearing impairments or providing escorts for tourists with visual impairments. In addition, it is important to organize regular seminars and trainings that will help to develop a respectful attitude towards people with disabilities and improve the quality of services. Such measures will not only increase the level of inclusion, but also strengthen the image of Uzbekistan as a hospitable country focused on the comfort and convenience of all visitors.



The development of inclusive tourism opens up significant economic prospects for Uzbekistan. According to international research, tourists with disabilities and their accompanying persons represent a significant segment of the market, ready to spend more on travel than other categories of tourists, provided that comfortable conditions are created. Investments in the adaptation of infrastructure and the creation of accessible services can be paid off by attracting this audience, increasing tourist flow and increasing tourism revenue. Moreover, inclusive tourism stimulates the development of related industries, including transport, hotel business and technology. For example, developing specialized mobile applications and platforms for finding accessible routes can not only improve the user experience of tourists, but also become an additional source of income for developers and startups. Thus, inclusive tourism becomes not only a social but also an economic investment in the country's future.

Digital technologies play an important role in creating comfortable conditions for tourists with disabilities. In Uzbekistan, the development of mobile applications that provide information about available routes, facilities and services is a promising direction. Such applications may include navigation features tailored to the needs of people with visual impairments, virtual tours for those who cannot physically visit facilities, and automatic sign language translation for people with hearing impairments. It is also worth considering the potential of social networks and web platforms for promoting inclusive tourism. For example, the creation of online communities for the exchange of experience and feedback of tourists with OVZ will help to identify the most sought-after destinations and improve existing services. Using artificial intelligence and big data to analyze tourist needs can contribute to more efficient route organization and adaptation of tourist infrastructure, making it accessible to all.

The development of inclusive tourism in Uzbekistan is an important step towards creating equal opportunities for all categories of citizens and guests of the country. This not only contributes to social integration, but also opens up new prospects for economic growth and improving the country's image on the international stage.
