Russian scientists Ingrid Bem and Jens Schneider believe that design activity is a method of organizing students' learning and career guidance during a certain period of education (academic year or semester). The introduction of the project method into education dates back to the 19th century. The theory of "cluster" first appeared in the field of economics. The versatility of the "cluster" theory essentially leads to the formation of different theoretical approaches. The growth of the student's knowledge occurs as a result of internal and external reading activities. If the internal factors include the student's work on himself, the process of striving to acquire the necessary

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knowledge, the external factors include the student's participation in the project process and the knowledge acquired through it.[4]

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Collaborative projects with the participation of various educational institutions, public and state organizations play an important role in the design activities. The participation of schoolchildren in the implementation of socially significant projects allows them to acquire excellent knowledge and high qualifications, and to acquire the skills of independent activity. For the first time, the ideas of social cooperation in the field of pedagogy were expressed in the works of D. Dewey, S. T. Shatsky, A. S.

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Makarenko. The scientific works of these authors present different views on the need for the educational institution to establish a strong relationship with the environment, the school with the family, the public, and non-governmental organizations in order for the child to grow up in the natural environment in real life.

The current situation in the education system shows that special and strong attention should be paid to this issue. It should be said that the modern pedagogical theory also emphasizes the need for broad social cooperation in the field of education, the reason being the leading social system that is inextricably linked with the education system, the main spheres of society, the economy, social structures, politics, and culture. is an institution.
