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Why Cadets And Officers Of Internal Affairs Of Uzbekistan Need English

All the required conditions, as well as wide range of opportunities have been created to learn foreign language skills, moreover, additional preferences are being introduced to students and professionals of any sphere who acquired foreign languages and obtained various certificates in our country. The payments and extra bonuses are quintessence of this mechanism.

Makhmudkho`ja Bekhbudiy, one of the participants of "Jadid" movement in Turkestan, was thoroughly concerned with the importance of foreign languages, stressing out that our youth should at least master four foreign languages as long as we do not want to lag behind the development.

To contemplate on teaching foreign languages especially for cadets of educational institutions of internal affairs, the plausible question arises that why every member of modern society generally needs English.
