Polyphonist-composers such as J. Palestrina, O. Lasso, K. Janeken, who lived in the 15th-16th centuries and created multivoice works in their work, contributed.

It is known that the subject of "musical culture" taught in secondary schools differs from other subjects in that it is organized on the basis of several activities. Among these activities, the activity of "singing as a group (choir)" is of particular importance, the main volume of the lesson is allocated to this activity, and the main goal is to develop students' vocal and choral skills.

Due to the fact that the formation of vocal-choir skills requires a long and continuous, systematic educational and creative process, the extremely limited number of hours allocated to the subject, this process should be carried out in a combination of extracurricular activities. requires work. At this point, let's briefly touch on the essence of the purpose and tasks of the "singing as a group" activity in school music education. The activity of "singing together" in school music education is very diverse and covers a wide range of educational activities, the most important of which is the formation of students' vocal and choral skills. This, in turn, creates a vocal sound, directs sound, breathes, spends it sparingly, how to take a breath, how to spend it (sound attack), musical hearing (hearing, feeling the sound at its height, pure intonation ( singing the sound at its own height), diction (pure pronunciation), articulation (ability to use the voice apparatus correctly), ensemble (achieving singing in accompaniment), tune (tuning to the tonality of the music, teacher's voice), depending on the note singing (reading from a sheet), understanding and following the conductor's cues while singing, "solfeggio" singing following the dynamic signs, and acquiring the skills and abilities of multi-voice singing. it seems that the ability to successfully implement such a wide range of tasks in a single lesson is very limited, because a 1-hour music lesson also includes a number of educational tasks (theoretical literacy, listening and analyzing music, performing rhythmic and dance movements), accompanying children on a musical instrument), these are the reasons why the success of the "group" performance" activity (in school music education, one class is considered as one team) with the activities of the choir outside the classroom is the fastest way to achieve the goal. It guarantees that it is the right, effective way.

Collective performance, that is, singing in a choir, requires a number of vocal choir skills, without which it is difficult to imagine singing in a choir. In order to teach students to sing in a choir, it is necessary to diligently and patiently master the vocal-choir skills and acquire the necessary skills. Singing in a group - choir teaches students a number of aspects, including the fact that when singing in a group, they hear others sing, unite into a single organism, and learn to sing with a sense of ensemble, in turn, this has a great influence on their moral and spiritual formation.

Nowadays, new forms of children's choir performances are emerging, the most important of which are:

- 1. Class-choir group in music lessons. (Instead, they perform at school cultural events and class concerts).
- 2. Children's choirs organized at school.
- 3. Choirs organized in children's art centers.
- 4. Children's choir studios.

The works included in the repertoire should be diverse in terms of theme and genre, including patriotism, motherland, mother nature, games-songs suitable for children, animals, plants, folklore works, works of local and foreign composers. it is desirable in all respects. All this makes new aspects of life invisible in the eyes of children. It develops their spiritual and moral world, musical taste and thinking.

First of all, it is important that in the content of educational work in children's choirs, all the requirements set by our state for the work of educating the young generation are reflected.
