Military oath. High moral and spiritual qualities of students are formed as a result of the entire path of real social life, the study of the theory of national independence in the departments of social sciences throughout the entire period of study at the university, and the influence of educational tools. It is carried out in an educational institution on the basis of a single comprehensive plan of public education.
