Overall to say here, the students of Argentina have an average of three hours of English classes per week. However, in some areas the number of learners is widely spread, to be clear such provinces as Catamarca, La Pampa, Tierra del Fuego or Buenos Aires City —for example in Formosa, 83% of secondary school



students are taught English, but only 6% of primary students are. This mainly responds to the fact that teaching a foreign language is not mandatory in that province.

Due to the disparities, regarding the regional differences in the case of primary school students, in secondary schools access to English classes “is widespread” and “practically all provinces have a coverage of over 75% and some, like Córdoba (94%), Río Negro (95%) and La Pampa (96%) have numbers close to universalization.” As it is obviously clear Argentina and its students are actively learning English in the adulthood period primarily as a great number of them are interested in being integrated into the world, a great portion of people move to USA, for example to pursue their studies or to work in the American cities such as New York, Boston and others. To crown it all, Argentinian Universities offer great opportunities for students to study properly and to gain knowledge with the possibilities to choose English as the main language of communication. English language possesses with roughly 1.53 billion speakers worldwide, making it the most widely used language on earth by total number of speakers in the world. Non-native speakers outnumber native speakers by nearly three to one, a ratio that has grown steadily for two decades.

In Peru, with a score of 49.32, the regions of Lima, La Libertad, and Arequipa show the best results with massive number of English speakers in the country. Mexico and Peru had increased the number of English



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speakers significantly, due to the issues of development of tourism in different areas.
