It is not without reason that he emphasized that the vital calling has taken a strong place in the minds and hearts of each of us, parents and the general public. After all, defining the perspective of the social, economic and cultural development of the Republic, implementing large-scale reforms in order to take a worthy place among the countries of the world community, studying the experiences of



developed countries, taking into account local conditions, economic and intellectual resources, fundamental reforms are being implemented in all spheres of society. is a factor that ensures the achievement of new achievements. Here, in the opinion of the first President of the Republic of Uzbekistan, I. Karimov, "The most important period in the physical and psychological development of a child is the primary school period", it is necessary to prepare our children for the future, to pay special attention to them, to implement advanced and modern methods of education, to raise the level of knowledge of pedagogues. it should be noted that many other relevant issues have not lost their relevance even today.

Accordingly, educating elementary school students who have an independent mind, intellectually developed worldview, directing them to creative activities, preparing them for creative activities, and realizing their creative abilities remains an urgent pedagogical problem as always. In particular, the pace of world development, the processes taking place in it, require a new approach to the educational process, as well as the implementation of innovations in all fields. First of all, this is seen in the problems related to the further improvement of educational programs, textbooks, methods, regular improvement of teacher-pedagogues recommendations, introduction of innovative and advanced information and educational technologies into the process.

In the methodical manual "Development of creative activity of students in teaching a foreign language" by one of our scientists F.R.Yuzlikaev and M.Najmiddinova, according to the opinion of I.P.Nikitina, the concept of "creativity" is not directly used in "philosophy of art", but "a person regularly uses his personal " tries to go beyond "limits": from his possibilities, his life and his world.

According to N.V. Kuzmina, the importance of the difference between creative and independent thinking is that creative thinking is independent thinking, but any active thinking and independent thinking in turn cannot be creative thinking. One of the important parts of a student's creative thinking is intuition. The



concept of intuition is used in various disciplines: philosophy, logic, mathematics, and psychology give different meanings to this concept.

Today, in the education of the young generation, instilling the main directions of the national idea into the minds of students, effective use of artistic educational tools and methods, formation of spiritual and political worldviews of students, and development of their creative abilities.

B. M. Teplov writes that abilities are a special mental characteristic of a person, a characteristic related to the successful performance of some activity, knowledge, skills and abilities previously developed by a person that do not lead to any result.

S. L. Rubinstein believes that abilities are attached to the system of generalized mental activities in a person, the difference between abilities and skills is not the result of strengthening the methods of actions, but the mental processes of activities controlled by actions.

V.S. Kuzin thinks about abilities as follows: abilities mean the qualities and characteristics of a person that serve to perform a certain type of activity at a high level.

In recent years, systematic work has been carried out in the country to improve the quality and efficiency of the education system, to form modern knowledge and skills of kindergarten students, primary school students and young students, to prepare them for creative activities and to guide them, to ensure the integrity and continuity of education.

At the same time, the current state of the national education system is necessary to modernize it based on the requirements of the times, to educate elementary school students to be highly educated, physically and spiritually healthy people, to increase the authority of the leaders and pedagogues of educational institutions, and to make them work effectively. requires the implementation of consistent measures to create conditions.

In his address to the Oliy Majlis, President Shavkat Mirziyoyev emphasized the need to improve school curricula based on advanced foreign experience, revise curriculum and subjects, adapt them to international standards, and improve



the quality of textbooks and literature. In addition, on August 14, 2018, the decision of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan "On measures to raise morally, morally and physically perfect young people, to raise the quality of their education system to a new level" and the task of reducing it by 10 percent has been set.

Paragraph 12 of the "Road map for preparing for the participation of the Republic of Uzbekistan in international studies on international evaluation programs" approved by the decision of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan on December 8, 2018 states that "starting from December 2019, state education standards based on the experience of advanced foreign countries, "The task of making gradual changes and additions to the content of educational programs and educational literature" is defined.

Also, in the PISA (The Program for International Student Assessment) international assessment program, computer-simulated interactive tasks are widely used to determine the literacy levels of primary school students, and all tests are carried out using computer technology.

Primary school is a secondary or general level of education, in which the student is given the most necessary and necessary knowledge in his life, as well as cultivates enthusiasm, love and respect for every information, the formation of mental, moral, creative activities, as well as the ability to think logically.

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
